L The image of the loving Shepherd featured in Psalm 23 reminds us that our Lord is always with us, ready to guide us and to support us. The image is one that resonates with young children and has been featured in hymns texts used in Sunday School hymnals. The hymn "Savior, like a Shepherd Lead Us" first appeared in a volume *Hymns for the Young, selected for the purpose of being committed to memory* in England in 1832. We might well follow the directive of the hymnbook's title and commit this special hymn to memory. We sing the first two stanzas of "Savior, like a Shepherd Lead Us."
