CHANGE in Peace Annual Voters Assembly – Better late than never. The Annual Peace Voters Meeting, which is normally held in June, will be held on Sunday, <u>August 23</u>, 2020 following the Worship Service. It, like many other things, has been delayed by steps to control the spread of COVID-19.

At the Annual Meeting, reports from various boards and committees will be received; the Work Plan (aka Budget) for the fiscal year 2020-2021 will be presented and adopted; elections will be held to fill leadership positions; and other appropriate business can be presented.

All communicant members aged fifteen and older are eligible to vote. All voters in good standing aged eighteen or older are eligible to hold elective office, subject to some restrictions.

Please plan to attend this important congregational event. All members are encouraged to follow COVID-19 safety practices. Masks and sanitizing material will be available and social distancing will be encouraged.
